- A. Enrollment confirmation must be completed via online status checking system.
- B. The original notarized diploma and transcript must be received before January 31, 2019.

Please note the diploma and full transcript issued outside of Taiwan must be notarized by Taiwan Embassy or Taipei Economic and Cultural Office (TECO) in the country/place where you received your degree. We encourage you to contact Taiwan Embassy or TECO in your country to determine how to apply, and the likely time required for the process of notarization to be accomplished. For Embassies or TECO ( Missions ) abroad, please check the website as below <http://www.mofa.gov.tw/en/default.html>. If your academic credentials are from Mainland China, The Regulations Governing the Accreditation of Schools in Mainland China shall apply.

Failing to submit the notarized documents to Division of International Students, Office of Global Affairs before the due date will result in cancellation of the admission.

- E. Please be aware that admission letter does not guarantee VISA issuance. NTHU has no influence over the issue of VISA.
- F. Without the approval of NTHU, students who have already registered in other universities are not allowed to simultaneously register at NTHU. Breaking thus rule would result in immediate cancellation of the applicant's admission or the deprivation of the applicant's recognized status as a NTHU registered student.
