****Official bank statement**

- (1) *An official bank statement is required and should be issued in English / Chinese (dated within the last 3 months) in the amount of USD 6,000 (NTD 200,000) or more.*
- (2) *In the case the bank statement is not issued in the name of the applicant, a signed declaration must be provided from the sponsor. In the declaration it should clearly state the sponsor's relationship with the applicant and commitment to cover the applicant's all expenses in Taiwan.*

A **notarized** English or Chinese **translation** should also be provided if your diploma and transcript are originally issued in other languages. **The notarization of diploma, transcript and their translations should be processed by a Taiwan Overseas Representative Office or Taiwan Embassy in or near the country where the documents are issued.**
