## FROM THE DESK OF THE PRESIDENT

Prabhat Kumar College, Contai, was established on 15th July, 1926 with a princely donation of late Biswambhar Dinda, the founder secretary, and supplementary financial assistance of the then generous zamindars of Contai Sub-division. Along with this, the enthusiastic eudcationists, the farsighted personalities of this region who are always remembered with honour for their leading role in the freedom movement of the country, came forward to make the initiative a reality.

Since then this college has marched forward, opened up a good number of disciplines including the PG course in physics in 2006, attained a great name and fame by providing facilities for higher education to the students community of this vast semi-urban region.

With the passage of time, silver jubilee, golden jubilee celebration of this institute had been arranged. But due to the lack of initiative of the exstudents as well as the absence of idea of relevance of any platform of them, the ex-students' union or alumni association whatever may be the name, could not be organized upto the 75th year of existence of the college.

On the occasion of the concluding ceremony of the year-long celebration of the 75th jubilee of this college one ex-students' re-union was organized on 30th April, 2002. In this assemblage more than thousand ex-students including some octogenarian and septuagenarian alumni were present and also participated in the reminiscence. This was the first of its kind in the history of this second oldset college in the undivided district of Midnapur, West Bengal.

A good number of ex-students became nostalgic while recolleting the eventful days of their early life in the alter of this Alma-Mater. The brotherhood and fellow-feeling among the students, the warmth of heart, erudition and genteelism of the then professors, sincere efforts of the authorities for the development of the college-all these were repeatedly mentioned by the participating speakers. The reference to different specific events in the history of freedom movement, like Quit India movement, etc. in which this college (with the involvement of all teachers-student-authorities) played a significant role in pre-independence era, unfolded once again its majestic and glorious position in the southern part of undivided Bengal.

The day-long programme included felicitations to the senior ex-students, cultural programme and athletic competition, presentation of awards, the reminiscence of those good old days-all these prompted some ex-students of

later generation to do something which would perpetuate this memorable symphony and which would continue to function as the link between past and present, and as the platform of amity and solidarity. This idea was spontaneously supported by all. As such a promoters-committee of some exstudents was formed with the request to shoulder the responsibility of organizing the proposed Alumni Association keeping consistency with the provisions of W.B. societies registration Act and Rules.

Accordingly the promoters committee took up the task of preparing the Bye-law of the Association. By overcoming the hurdles like lack of experience and non-availability of the guiding documents in this region, the committee, however prepared a draft of proposed Bye-law. The draft along with the Memorandum of Association was registered by the concerned Dept. of Govt. of West Bengal. Since then the Alumni Association had started functioning as per the guideline incorporated in the Memorandum of Association.

This Association will always feel proud of the eventful past, will actively cooperate with the blooming present, and ardently expect the rosy future of this college, the center of higher education and socio-cultural motivation of the young learners.

### **MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION**

# P.O.- CONTAI, PURBA MEDINIPUR, W.B.

- 1. The name of society shall be : Contai P.K. College Alumni Association.
- The Registered office of the Association shall be situated at : P.K. College, Contai, P.O.- Contai, Dist.- Puba Medinipur, Pin- 721401, West Bengal.
- 3. The objects for which the association is established are :
  - To promote sympathy and fellow-feeling, unity and mutual-help among the members, the ex-students of P.K. College, Contai.
  - To enhance the spirit of co-operation and brother-hood amongst the members, by organizing different programmes-social, economic, educational and philanthropic.
  - iii) To render all possible assitance to the aged, sick, helpless and indigent members to overcome contingencies.
  - iv) To help the needy students, particulary of P.K Collage, Contai, for the prosecution of studies at diffrent levels.
  - v) To arrange and organize lectures., debates, discussions, seminars and excursions etc. for the diffusion of knowledge in various fields of education and culture.
  - vi) To publish or cause to be published useful literature, magazines, books etc. on the history of the collage, histroy of this region, particulary its problems, progress and position in the field of higher education.
  - vii) To set up library, reading-room, students' health- home, old age home, Gymnasium, art craft-music training centre etc.
  - viii) To take initaive or to cooperate with any initiative taken by any other organization for promoting and encouraging the advancement in the literary and cultural, scientific and technical, vocational and medical, legal and physical education in this region, particulary in the premises of P.K Collage, Contai.
  - ix) To encourage and assist in such other philianthropic activities as may be deemed appropriate by the Executive Committe of the association.
  - x) To organize "Mock- Interviews" and to set up "Carrier Counselling Cell" for the out going students so that they can face the challenge ahead.

- xi) To arrange the homecoming of Alumni ex-students reunion occasionally at the campus of their Alma Mater.
- xii) To collect membership subscription, admission free, donation etc. for a particular or general purpose and or raise funds through the arrangement of social / cultural performances.
- xiii) To do all such things, which will help getting the Government grant, donation from the benevolent persons for raising the fund for mitigating the specific projects consistent with the objects of the association.

# Synopsis of the activities for the Session - 1920-1921 & 1921-1922

### Participation in the Seminar on "Economic Self dependence of Fishermen"



### Competencies developed at the institution, Alumni prominent position:

The Contai P.K. The chosen topics, their elaborate disussion through debate and demonstration are given here-under:

- a) Value Education: We have organised several seminers in the colleges and schools on great heroes and eminent personalities like Swami Vivekananda, Sister Nivedita, Birendra Nath Sasmal, Mahatma Gandhi, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, Iswarchandra Vidyasagar, Acharya Jagadish Chandra Bose, Satyendra Nath Bose, Acharya Prafulla Chandra Roy and the like to reminisce their self-sacrifice, immense contribution to the freedom strugle and their self-less service to the downtrodden in order to buildup moral character of the students, awaken their social responsibility and remind them of their liability to the humanity at large.
- b) We have organised a number of health-oriented camps to develop health awareness among the students and the public in general.
- c) We have organised Gita Charcha and other spiritual programmes to help develop a secular bent of mind and to make the students respectful to every faith and creed in the perspective of religious squables and fanaticism.
- d) We have organised cultural competitions like Quiz Contest, recitations, Songs, dramas etc. to develop their creative outlook and mutual understanding.

In short, our on-going march will include all such humble attempts to develop competencies at the college.

# Alumni Meeting-nature and outcome, plans to generate resource

A number of Alumni meeting Excutive and General —— had been held during the period from 2017 to 2021 to adopt important resolution and devise ways and means to execute the same with a view to help promoting the all-round welfare of our Alma Mater, Contai P.K. College.

From time to time, the Alumni Association reviews the outcome of thier endeavour, its success and failure and chalks out plans to generate resources.

Now the gist of the Annual General Meetings is given below:

- i) The XIV th AGM attended by 163 members was held on 12.12.2017 in the seminar hall. Two significant issues transpired in the deleberation.
  - a) The College guesthouse to be renovated.
  - b) The college authority was repeatedly requested to instal three (3) busts of the 3 Ex. Principals in the college campus, namely Late Nepal Chandra Roy, the founder Principal, The chief architect of institution Principal Late Banabehari Maity, and Principal Late Jiban Krishna Panigrahi.
- ii) The XV th AGM attended by, 156 members was held on 04.03.2018 in which so many issues, came up for consideration and consequent measure:
  - a) Lives and contribution of the great men- patriots, martyrs, poets, writers, social activists - were elaborately discussed in the sorrounding school. Along with this, the Foundation Day and the Founder's Day of the college were also observed and the speakers threw light on these events in the meeting.
  - b) In order to awaken patriotism in the new generation, our association vividly elaborated various significant aspects of the Freedom Struggle including the Quit India Movement.
  - c) The full-fledged history of our college has yet to be written for the students and the public in general, though one of our Alumni Scholars - Dr. Naresh Chandra Nanda, tried to venture in this direction but it was not so elaborate.

- d) The Association feels the necessity of publishing a very short life history (biography) of the greatmen whose busts have been installed in different parts of Contai Municipality limiting the span of printing from 5 to 6 pages.
- e) Our Association has tried its level best to establish a cultural and social relationship among the town schools and the college.
- f) The Association has time and again, drawn the attention of the respected Principal to build an Auditorum. To that effect, the Alumni have donated to their utmost, as much as possible, and created a fund from 2002 to 2003. Mention can be made that an amount of Rs. 5,73,000 has been collected during the years 2016-2019 which has already been transferred to the same fund.

Besides this, the association boasts of maintaining two prestigious funds :-

- i) One Dipanwita Award Fund comprising Rs. 50,000/- donated by Dibyendu Adhikari (Vice President of the Association) in memory of his beloved daughter Dipanwita to award prizes to 5 P.G. Students obtaining highest marks in each of the 5 disciplines.
- ii) The other Late Nisharani Giri Award comprising Rs. 50,000/- donated by Prof. Gourhari Giri in memory of his Late wife 'Nisharani' to award prizes to the 5 U.G. students of different faculties.
- iii) The XVI th AGM was held on 10.03.2019 with an attendance of 150 members.
  - (a) Games, sports and cultural competition were arranged among the students of the schools and the colleges of the surrounding areas.
  - (b) The college may attach importance to Alumni Association in times of difficulty when unexpected problems stall the smooth functioning of the institution.
  - (c) Quiz contests may be arranged among the school and college students.
  - (d) Similarly, health awareness camps may be conducted.
  - (e) The college should arrange for Yoga-Pranayam camps for building Physical fitness and mental restraint.
- iv) The XVII th AGM was held on 08.03.2020 attended by 161 members.

  - (a) This time too the construction of an Auditorim figured in the discussion.
  - (b) A sufficiently wide metal / Concrete Road may be constructed from the 1st gate to the 2nd gate of the college and that only after the renovation of the 1st gate along with the beautification on both sides of the road.
  - (c) P.G. Courses in various other science Disciplines be opened in the college to make Higher Education easily available to the students- especially economically backward.
- v) The XVIII th AGM was held with 85 members present in the Hall on 05.02.2021.
  - (a) With a view to writing a complete as well as an authentic history of Contai P.K. College from its inception till date, all the Alumni members, especially the aged ones, were requested to submit their knowledge and experience in writing comprising 3 to 4 pages to the proper authority.
  - (b) The Alumni Associasion could not proceed further as all the schools and colleges were closed in the wake of the COVID-19 Pandemic.

### Suggestions for active functioning of Alumni Association

As outlined in the Memorandum of the Contai P.K. college Alumni Association the undernoted programmes of activities have been taken into consideration for future execution.

- 1) To organise Mock-interview for the pass-out students.
- To impart training to the students in communicative English.
- To arrange comprehensive awareness and campaign programme in schools & colleges and selected villages on illiteracy, child-labour, pollution, superstitions, Humanrights including women securities.
- 4) To search out HIV positive patients if any.
- 5) To detect Thalasomia patients, if any.
- 6) To arrange sports, Socio-cultural competitions at different levels like Inter-College, Inter-school etc.
- 7) To arrange First-Aid and maternity training camps.
- 8) To arrange Seminar on topics related to health, Education, national integrity, communal harmony, social securities of women and children etc.
- To publish and / or to co-operate with any effort to publish the history of the college as well as the history of Contai Sub-division.
- 10) To provide all sorts of assistance and co-operation to the P.K. College Authorities in their endeavour to get the recognition for the college as the Institution of excellence.
