These activities are the outcome of whole hearted efforts of all the concerned stakeholders which includes the team members of UBA, student volunteers, members of external agency and villagers.

Activities Performed by UBA Unit, Prabhat Kumar College, Contai

The UBA unit of Prabhat Kumar College has conducted the household level survey on five adopted villages (Total 1067 households surveyed). The Summary report of respective village is following-

Village Name: Srirampur

Srirampur village is situated at Contai I Block in Purba Medinipur district of West Bengal, India. Tamluk and Contai are the district & sub-district headquarters of Payrachali village respectively. Sabajput is the gram panchayat of Srirampur village. The distance of this village from Prabhat Kumar College is nearly 2.9 km.

The total land area of Srirampur is around 150.54 hectares (371.99 acres). which consists of a total household of around 672. The nearest town to Srirampur is Contai.

The total population of Srirampur is around 3274 of which male population is around 1664 and female population comprises of 1610. Nearly 13.74 percent of total population belongs to the age group of 0-6 years. Both the average sex ratio and the child sex ratio are appeared to be higher than the West Bengal state average.

The literacy rate in Srirampur village is nearly 82 percent. The gender gap in literacy is relatively high and it found to be 13 percentage points in favour of male literacy rate.

In this village out of 1060 workers, 802 workers (75.66 percent) have reported their working status as main workers. On the other hand, nearly 52 percent women workers are working as marginal workers.

Village Location:

Village Name: Payrachali

The village Payrachali is located in Contai I subdivision of Purba Medinipur district in West Bengal, India. Tamluk and Contai are the district & sub-district headquarters of Payrachali village respectively. Sabajput is the gram panchayat of Payrachali village. The distance of this

village from Prabhat Kumar College is nearly 4.5 km. The village code of Payrachali village is 346177.

The total geographical area of village is 23.74 hectares. Payrachali has a total 84 households with population of 382 peoples, out of which male population is 195 while female population is 187. Total 52 children belonging to the age category of (0-6) years, out of these 25 are male children and 27 are female children. Both the average sex ratio and the child sex ratio are appeared to be far above than the state level figures in this regard. Literacy rate of payrachali village is found to be 86.97 percent out of which 96.47% males and 76.88% females are literate.

Out of total 125 workers, 98.25 percent respondents have reported their status as main workers. Most of them are working either as cultivators or as agricultural labourers. Very few women are found to be engaged in livelihood activities.

Village Name: Jagannathpur

Jagannathpur 2nd Part village is located in Contai I subdivision of Purba Medinipur district in West Bengal, India. Tamluk and Contai are the district & sub-district headquarters of Jagannathpur 2nd Part village respectively. Sabajput is the gram panchayat of Jagannathpur 2nd Part village. The village code of Jagannathpur 2nd Part village is 346169

The total geographical area of village is 44.76 hectares. Jagannathpur 2nd Part has 147 households with total population of 716 peoples, out of which male population is 368 while female population is 348. Literacy rate of Jagannathpur 2nd part village is 78.35% out of which 86.96% males and 69.25% females are literate. There are about 147 houses in Jagannathpur 2nd part village.

In Jagannathpur village, the population of children belonging to the age group of (0-6) years is 68, out of which, total 19 are male and remaining 42 are female. Average sex ratio is found to be 946 which is less than the state level average sex ratio of 950. The child sex ratio (1615) is appeared to be much higher than the West Bengal average of 956. In this village, the gender gap in literacy rate is appeared to be nearly 15 percentage point in favour of male population. As regards livelihood pattern of the villagers, only 4.85 percent of workers reported their work as main work while other 95.15 percent were involved in marginal activity. The female work participation rate is appeared to be extremely low (only 5.17 percent) in this village.

Village Name: Banamalipur

Banamalipur village is located in Contai I subdivision of Purba Medinipur district in West Bengal, India. Tamluk and Contai are the district & sub-district headquarters of Banamalipur village respectively. The village code of Banamalipur village is 346168. Sabajput is the gram panchayat of Banamalipur village. The total geographical area of village is 31.81 hectares. Banamalipur has 125 families with a total population of 618 peoples, out of which male population is 325 while female population is 293. The number of children belonging to the age group of (0-6) years is 68, out of which 26 are male children and 20 are female children. The average sex ratio in this village is found to be very low and it is recorded as 902. The child sex ratio is just 769 in this highly literate village. Literacy rate of Banamalipur village is 98.60 % out of which 99% males and 98.17% females are literate

In this village, most of the workers (nearly 92.27 percent) describe their work as main work and are involved in agriculture activities. The female work participation rate is appeared to be very low and only 33 females are engaged in livelihood activities.

Village Name: Bankaberya

Bankaberya village is located in Contai I subdivision of Purba Medinipur district in West Bengal, India. Tamluk and Contai are the district & sub-district headquarters of Bankaberya

village respectively. As per 2009 stats, Sabajput is the gram panchayat of Bankaberya village. The village code of Bankaberya village is 346171.

The total geographical area of village is 62.05 hectares. Bankaberya has 201 houses with total population of 851 peoples, out of which male population is 444 while female population is 407. Total 88 children are in the age category of (0-6) years, out of these 46 are male children and 42 are female children. The average sex ratio in this village is 917 whereas child sex ratio (913) is found to be far less than the average sex ratio. Literacy rate of Bankaberya village is 93.71 percent out of which 97.49 percent males and 89.59 percent females are literate.
